Rules

ENTRY FEES: 4-H classes, Owner to Ride and Carl Dellinger Memorial Classes are free; Regular Classes - \$6.00 and Championship Classes - \$8.00. Entries received after July 17, 2016 will be charged a one-time only Post Entry Fee of \$5.00 per horse or pony. Entry Fees must accompany Entry Form – will accept a signed blank check. Please **DO NOT SEND CASH** in the mail. No telephone or e-mail entries will be accepted. There will be an additional charge of \$28.00 for any check returned by the bank. No refund on any class unless due to bonafide injury to horse or rider unless certificate is provided.

PASSES: There will be two (2) **FREE PASSES PER HORSE OR PONY** if entries are received on or before July 17, 2016. All exhibitors without passes must pay regular gate admission – no exceptions and no refunds for those that have to pay. **Only tow vehicles allowed on the grounds.** All other vehicles must park in the general parking area.

COGGINS: New Hampshire Horses: A negative USDA-approved Equine Infectious Anemia (EIA) test (i.e. Coggins or Elisa) within the previous twelve (12) months is recommended. Out-of-state Animals: All equines entering the State of New Hampshire must be accompanied by a current negative A.G.I.D. or ELISA (Coggins) test for Equine Infectious Anemia conducted within (6) months prior to entry. This must be presented at the Horse Show Office.

RABIES: Must present proof of Rabies Shots at Horse Show Office.

RIBBONS: Ribbons will be awarded through six (6) places.

TROPHY: There will be a trophy awarded to all winners.

AGE as of January 1, 2016: Adults – 19 and over; Youth – 18 years of age and under; Walk-Trot – 12 years and under; Leadline – 8 years and under: 4-H – Juniors 8 – 11, Intermediate 12 – 13 and Seniors 14 – 18; or unless otherwise noted in the program.

HELMETS: All exhibitors age 18 and under must wear headgear approved by and conform to the ASTM standards. Harness must be secured and properly fitted.

Exhibitors in all classes shall be neatly and cleanly attired appropriately for the class in which they are exhibiting. Chaps, derbies and coats are optional.

No training equipment will be allowed in the ring.

The Management reserves the right to combine or cancel classes that have fewer than four (4) entries.

Any exhibitor in a walk, trot/jog class cannot enter a class requiring a canter/lope. Also, any exhibitor in a class requiring a canter/lope will not be eligible for a walk, trot/jog only class. **EXCEPTION** will be for the Green Horse/Pony Division – Walk-Trot/Jog (no status as to exhibitor).

Unsportsmanship conduct will not be permitted.

Please **DO NOT BLOCK THE IN OR OUT GATES.**

Day of show, **POST ENTRIES accepted but** must be made two classes prior to the class you wish to enter.

No running the gate. Thank you.

4-H Division

Open only to members enrolled in a 4-H club (New Hampshire or Vermont) fulfilling the requirements as stated in the Member's Project Guide. Exhibitor must provide a copy of their current **4-H Animal Approval Form**. Classes to be judged according to 4-H rules.

Class # 1 – 4-H Fitting & Showmanship. A) Junior; B) Intermediate or C) Senior

Class # 9 – 4-H Equitation – Open. A) Junior; B) Intermediate or C) Senior

Class # 28 – 4-H Pleasure Horse Class. A) Junior; B) Intermediate or C) Senior

OPEN SHOWMANSHIP

To be judged on showmanship with equine shown in hand, standing and at a walk and trot on the line. To be judged 40% on condition, grooming, tack, 10% on exhibitor appearance and 50% on leading, showing to best advantage and poise.

Class # 2 – Adult Showmanship

Class # 3 – Youth Showmanship

EQUITATION DIVISION

Horses to enter the ring at a walk. Riders to be judged at a walk, trot/jog and canter/lope both ways of the ring and must be on the correct lead. Martingales prohibited. Riders will be judged on seat, hands, performance of horse, appointments of horse & rider and suitability of horse to rider. All horses are required to back. Judge may ask for additional individual performance.

Class # 10 – Adult Western/Reining Seat Equitation

Class # 13 – Adult Hunt Seat Equitation

Class # 29 – Adult Equitation Championship. To be eligible, riders must have been entered, shown and Judged in Class # 10 or Class # 13.

Class # 20 – Youth Western/Reining Seat Equitation

Class # 24 – Youth Hunt Seat Equitation

Class # 39 – Youth Equitation Championship. To be eligible, riders must have been entered, shown and Judged in Class # 20 or Class # 24.

EQUITATION – WALK-TROT/JOG

Martingales prohibited. Riders to be judged at a walk, trot/jog both ways of the ring. Riders will be judged on seat, hands, performance of horse, appointments of horse & rider and suitability of horse to rider. Horses are required to back.

Class # 14 – Adult Walk-Trot/Jog Equitation – Open

Class # 15 – Youth Walk-Trot/Jog Equitation – Open

Class # 23 – Adult & Youth Walk-Trot/Jog Equitation Championship. To be eligible, riders must have been entered, shown and judged in Class # 14 or Class # 15.

LEADLINE DIVISION

Open to riders 8 & under. Riders cannot compete in any other classes except leadline at this show. An adult shall be required to lead entry. Handlers and riders shall be properly attired. To be shown at a walk & trot/jog both ways of the ring. Riders must be able to ride unassisted. Classes will be judged on elementary fundamentals of horsemanship. Suitability of mount to rider to count.

Class # 21 – Leadline Equitation – Open

Class # 27 – Leadline Pleasure – Open

Class # 30 – Leadline Championship. To be eligible, must have been entered, shown and judged in Class # 21 and/or Class # 27.

HORSE IN HAND DIVISION

Horses can only show in one class in this Division (no cross entering).

Class # 5 – Western Horse in Hand. Entries shall be judged at a walk and jog on the line and then standing individually. Emphasis shall be placed on type, conformation, substance, quality and manners as a Western mount.

Class # 6 – Hunter Horse in Hand. Entries shall be judged at a walk and trot on the line and standing individually. Emphasis shall be placed on type, quality, conformation, finish and suitability as a Hunter mount.

PONY DIVISION

Class # 8 – Pony in Hand. Open to all ponies 14.2 hands and under. To be judged individually, standing, and then at a walk and trot on the line. To be judged on breed type, conformation, quality, substance, way of going, disposition and manners.

Class # 19 – Pony Pleasure under Saddle – Open. To be shown at a walk, trot/jog and canter/lope with extreme speed to be penalized. To be judged on manners, performance and quality.

Class # 41 – Pony Pleasure under Saddle Championship. Specifications same as qualifying class. Open to ponies that have been entered, shown and judged in Class # 19.

JUNIOR EXHIBITOR'S HACK

Class # 17 – Junior Exhibitor's Hack. Open to Saddle Seat or Hunt Seat horses. To be ridden by exhibitors under 18 years of age. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter on a reasonably loose rein but without loss of contact. Shall be judged on manners, performance, suitability and quality. May be divided "under 14 or 14 to 18 years" of age if sufficient entries.

Class # 36 – Junior Exhibitor's Hack Championship. Specifications same as qualifying class. To be eligible, must have been entered, shown and judged in Class # 17.

ROAD HACK DIVISION

Class # 26 – Road Hack. Open to Saddle Seat or Hunt Seat horses. Shall be shown on a reasonably loose rein without loss of contact at a flat-footed walk, trot, extended trot, canter and hand gallop. Shall stand quietly and back readily. Will be judged on performance, substance and manners.

Class # 44 – Road Hack Championship. Specifications same as qualifying class. To be eligible, horses must have been entered, shown and judged in Class # 26.

WALK-TROT/JOG PLEASURE

Riders in walk-trot/jog classes are not eligible to show in any canter/lope classes at this show. To be shown at a walk & trot/jog only. Reverse at the walk only. To be judged on manners, suitability of a horse/pony to rider and performance.

Class # 33 – Adult Walk-Trot/Jog Pleasure – Open

Class # 34 – Youth Walk-Trot/Jog Pleasure – Open

Class # 37 – Adult/Youth Walk-Trot/Jog Pleasure Championship. To be eligible, must have been entered, shown and judged in class # 33 or Class # 34.

PLEASURE DIVISION

Class # 16 – Ladies Pleasure Horse. Rides to be 19 years of age or over. May be shown Saddle Seat, Hunt Seat or Western. To be shown at a walk, trot/jog and canter/lope. May be asked to back. To be judged on manners, performance and suitability.

Class # 40 – Gentlemen’s Pleasure Horse. Riders to be 19 years of age or over. May be shown Saddle Seat, Hunt Seat or Western. To be shown at a walk, trot/jog and canter/lope. May be asked to back. To be judged on manners, performance and suitability.

Class # 31 – Hunter Pleasure Horse. Open to horses of a hunter type. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse’s mouth is required. To be judged on manners, performance, quality, presence, substance and soundness.

Class # 42 – Hunter Pleasure Horse Championship. Specifications same as qualifying class. To be eligible, horses must have been entered, shown and judged in Class #31.

Class # 32 – Western Pleasure Horse. Open to horses ordinarily used for pleasure purposes. To be shown at a walk, jog and lope on a reasonably loose rein without undue restraint. All horses are required to back. To be judged on manners, performance and quality.

Class # 43 – Western Pleasure Horse Championship. Specifications same as qualifying class. To be eligible, horses must have been entered, shown and judged in Class #32.

MINIATURE HORSE DIVISION (Section A & B combined)

Class # 7 – Miniature Horse in Hand Open. To be shown in hand at a walk and trot both ways of the ring, halter or bridle permitted. Whips prohibited. Horse must not be stretched. To be judged on conformation, type, soundness, quality, presence and manners.

Class # 12 – Miniature Horse in Hand Championship Open. Specifications same as qualifying class. To be eligible must have been entered, shown and judged in Class # 7.

Class # 22 – Miniature Horse Driving Open. To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, collected trot and walking trot. Horses will be required to stand quietly and rein back. Driving to be judged 60% on performance, manners and way of going; 30% on condition, fit and appropriateness of harness and vehicle; and 10% on neatness, appropriateness of attire and overall impression.

Class # 25 – Miniature Horse Driving Championship Open. Specifications same as qualifying class. To be eligible must have been entered, shown and judged in Class # 22.

Class # 4 – Miniature Horse Showmanship – Youth and Adults combined. To be judged on the handler’s ability to present a halter horse and execute a showmanship pattern to be decided by the judge, conformation and quality not to count.

Class # 53 – Miniature Horse Trail Open.

MEMORIAL TROPHY CLASSES (no charge)

Class # 35 – Owner to Ride. Open to horses and/or ponies. Riders must be owner on the entry form. To be shown at a walk, trot/jog and canter/lope both ways of the ring. To be judged on manners, performance and suitability to rider. Entries to be asked to back. In **Memory of Calvin Perkins.**

Class # 38 – Carl Dellinger Memorial Pleasure Horse Class – Open. All entries must have been entered and shown in at least one pleasure class at this show in a walk, trot/jog and canter/lope. To be shown at a walk, trot/jog and canter/lope both ways of the ring on a reasonably loose rein without undue restraint but without loss of contact. All horses required to back. To be judged on manners, performance and quality. All horses shall be judged on their respective merits regardless of type.

YOUTH HUNTER PLEASURE HORSE

Open to all horses of a “hunter type” ordinarily used for pleasure purposes. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse’s mouth is required. To be judged on manners, performance, quality, presence, substance and soundness.

Class # 11 – Youth Hunter Pleasure Horse.

Class # 18 – Youth Hunter Pleasure Horse Championship. To be eligible, must have been entered, shown and judged in Class # 11.

GAMES

Class # 45 – Egg and Spoon – no charge

Class # 46 – Sit-A-Buck (must provide your own dollar). Winner gets the “buck(s)”.

TRAIL DIVISION

All trail classes will be held in the North Haverhill Fair Forest. To be judged between 9:30 a.m. and 12:00 noon. No horse may enter more than one class. Martingales not allowed. Judged for suitability for use on country trails. Must demonstrate free and quiet way of going with comfort of rider to horse or pony. The gait between obstacles will be at the discretion of the Judge. Time in excess of 30 seconds in approaching an obstacle will eliminate the score for that obstacle.
