GENERAL RULES

1. Prize money is as follows: 1st=\$75, 2nd=\$50, 3rd=\$35, 4th=\$25, and 5th=\$15. Full prize money is paid to each person for two-person events. An overall champion shall be determined by totaling the points won by each competitor. All contests to be considered for overall points; 5 points are earned for first place, down to one point for fifth place for each event. Ties for the overall will be broken by awarding it to the competitor with the most first places, second places, etc. A special trophy and \$100 will be awarded to the person with the most points all contests considered; 2nd Place awarded \$50 and 3rd Place \$25 (Men & Women Overall Divisions). A special trophy and \$100 will be awarded to the person who is over 60 years of age as of July 1st with the most points all contests considered; and 2nd Place awarded \$50; and 3rd Place \$25
2. Contestants will strive to project a professional atmosphere at all times. Contestants who do not conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner will automatically be disqualified by the Head Judge or any acting officials.
3. **Only** competitors competing in an event will be allowed in the competition area at the time of that event. **No** family members, friends, or pets will be allowed in the competition area at **any** time.
4. Decisions of the judges will be final in any and all matters pertaining to the contest and its rules.
5. No contestant may enter any event more than once.
6. The specific rules of each event will be explained at a competitor's meeting just before the start of the contest. All questions will be answered at this time.
7. In chainsaw event, after a saw is used it will be kept in the ring until completion of the heat or event.
8. The official and final results of the competition will be announced after each event with the presentation of awards after all events are competed. The Overall Champion and Runner-ups in both the women's and men's events will be announced with the presentation of a trophy and cash prizes.
9. Starting before the word "Go" in any event will result in disqualification.
10. Alcoholic beverages will not be allowed in the competition area. Any contestant in violation of this rule, or under the influence of alcohol, will be disqualified.
11. Competitors must confirm registration by 10:00 AM on the day of the contest.

INDIVIDUAL EVENT RULES

1. LOG ROLLING: Each two-person team will be scored on the time it takes them to roll a log from two starting stakes to a determined point and back to the starting point using only peaveys or cant dogs. The log must rest against stakes at both ends of the course with wood showing beyond each stake. Contestants may not observe other contestants rolling the log until after they have taken their turn. Rules will be explained to each team before they begin to roll. Hands and feet may not be used to roll the log. Time starts on "Go".
2. JACK AND JILL CROSSCUT: Each man and woman team will be scored on the time it takes them to cut off two (2) complete cuts from a 10" X 10" pine timber. Cuts must be between lines established by judges. Time starts on "Go".

3. AXE THROWING: (Men & Women Divisions) The center of the bull's eye should be approximately 60 inches from the ground with five scoring areas. The bull's eye shall score 5 points, the next outer area 4 points, the next outer area 3 points, the next outer area 2 points, and the out most area 1 point. One practice throw will be allowed. Each contestant will have three throws - all to count. Axe needs only to cut outer edge of the line scoring area to win the points of the area. If both blades stick, no score will be given. Contestants must stand behind a line 20 feet from base of the target. The axe must be double-bitted, at least 2½ pounds, and have at least a 24 inch over-all handle length. Face of the blade shall not exceed six (6) inches. Ties will be throw-off to the first 5 places.
4. BOW SAW: (Men & Women Divisions) Each contestant will be scored on the time it takes to cut off one (1) complete section from a 10"x10" pine timber. Cuts must be between lines established by judges. Time starts on "Go".
5. HORIZONTAL CHOPPING:(Men and Women Divisions) Each contestant will be scored on the time it takes to chop completely through a 10" X 10" pine timber. Timbers will be assigned. Contestants will be required to set up their own block. There will be 2" X 4"s available for contestants to build stanchions. Time starts on "Go".
6. TWO-PERSON CROSSCUT: Each two-person team will be scored on the time it takes them to cut off two (2) complete sections from a 10"X10" pine timber. Cuts must be between lines established by judges. Time starts on "Go".
7. SUPER MODIFIED SAWS:
 - A. Three (3) complete cuts - down, up, down within six (6) inches of wood.
 - B. Cuts must be between lines established by judges.
 - C. Same saw may be used only once in event.
 - D. One minute warm-up prior to start.
 - E. Saws on ground **not** running, hands on wood.
 - F. Time starts on "Go". No starting ahead of time or you will be disqualified.
 - G. Safety chaps and eye protection **MUST** be worn.
